### **ADMISSION POLICY**

Admission Procedure For Intermediate Programme:

Candidates who have appeared in Matriculation or O-Level examinations are eligible for admission in the first year. They will be allowed to register for pre-classes and admissions. Admissions are strictly based on merit. A minimum of 45% marks (second division) in Matriculation examinations or its equivalence for the O-Level is required. The age requirement is 18 years or below. Admission dates are subject to declaration of board results for Matriculation Examinations and will be advertised in leading newspapers.

### After the declaration of the SSC (Matric) result by the Board, the formal registration will require the following documents:

- Three passport size photographs with white backgrounds.
- Copy of student B-Form/CNIC.
- Copy of Father/Guardian CNIC.
- Copy of SSC result cards issued by the B.I.S.E..
- Original NOC (Only for migrated students from Other Board).
- Original NOC (Only for migrated students from College to College).
- Attested copy of Equivalence Certificate issue by the IBCC (Only for O-Level students).
- Only O-Level students result issue in 2nd Cambridge examination.
- December/January is not eligible for the regular admission.

### Admission procedure for Undergraduate Degree Programme:

Candidates who have appeared in Intermediate or A-Level examinations are eligible for Undergraduate Degree Programme admission. Admissions are strictly based on merit. A minimum of 45% marks (second division) in Matriculation/ Intermediate examinations or its equivalence for the O/A-Level is required. The age requirement is 20 years or below. Admission dates are subject to declaration of board results for Intermediate/A-Level examinations and will be advertised in leading newspapers.

## After the declaration of the HSSC (Intermediate) result by the Board, the formal registration will require the following documents:

- Three passport size photographs with white backgrounds.
- Copy of student B-Form/CNIC.
- Copy of Father/Guardian CNIC
- Copy of SSC result cards issued by the B.I.S.E.
- Copy of HSSC result cards issued by the B.I.S.E..
- Attested copy of Equivalence Certificate issue by the IBCC (Only for A-Level students).
- Three copy of Domicile (Only for G.C.U.F).
- The candidate holding 3rd division in HSSC is not eligible for the admission.
- The candidates holding F.A/F.Sc or equivalent qualification with at least 2nd division and age not more than 24 years are eligible for admission in ADA/ADS/ADC/BS or equivalent programs.

### For Enrolment, the College Administration Requires Students to Abide by College Rules and Regulations:

All students enrolled at Concordia College are expected to uphold the highest standards of behavior, discipline, and academic integrity. The following policies are mandatory and non-negotiable:

### **Attendance Policy**

- Students must maintain a minimum of 80% attendance in all subjects to be eligible for internal and board examinations.
- · Absenteeism without a valid reason or prior approval will be considered a violation.
- Late arrivals (after the first 10 minutes of class) will be marked as late. Three late arrivals will count as one absence.
- Students missing classes due to illness must submit a medical certificate within 3 working days.

### Discipline and Behavior

- All students must show respect to faculty, staff, peers, and campus property at all times.
- Use of abusive language, bullying, harassment, or threats (verbal or physical) will result in disciplinary action.
- Students must avoid any behavior that disrupts the academic environment or damages the college's reputation.

### Misconduct

- Cheating, plagiarism, or any form of academic dishonesty is strictly prohibited and may result in expulsion.
- Possession of prohibited items (e.g., weapons, drugs, vapes, alcohol) will result in immediate disciplinary action and possible legal consequences.
- Participation in political, religious, or unauthorized group activities on campus is not allowed without prior approval.

### **Uniform Policy**

- Students must wear the prescribed uniform daily as per the college's dress code.
- Uniforms must be clean, properly worn, and complete at all times during college hours.
- Students not in proper uniform may be denied entry or marked absent.

### Adherence to BISE Policy

- All students of Intermediate level must strictly follow the rules and regulations set by the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education (BISE).
- Any violation of BISE examination policies, including unfair means, may result in cancellation of exams and legal action by the board.
